Thank you for assisting with our Per Capita responsibility. We have collected \$2,146 towards the \$11,098 that we owe to the denomination.

This represents close to 19% of the congregation. Last year we had roughly 20% participation. It's not too late to consider helping with this cost by sending a check marked "per capita" and made out to Christ Presbyterian Church for \$31.00.

Per Capita is a set amount of money (an apportionment) per member that congregations pay to the larger Presbyterian Church (USA). It is part of the glue that holds Presbyterians together. Every Presbyterian shares the benefit of the PC(USA)'s system of government, so every Presbyterian is asked to share the expenses associated with coordinating and performing the functions of that system.
