### Would you help us meet our Per Capita responsibility?

Per Capita is a set amount of money (an apportionment) per member that congregations pay to the larger Presbyterian Church (USA). It is part of the glue that holds Presbyterians together. Every Presbyterian shares the benefit of the PC(USA)'s system of government, so every Presbyterian is asked to share the expenses associated with coordinating and performing the functions of that system. Session is asking that each member consider helping with this cost by sending a check marked "per capita" and made out to Christ Presbyterian Church for \$31.00. This will help relieve the strains on the 2018 budget.
