□ Temporary Hosting, August 1-31

The temporary hosting opportunity allows you to open your house to an International student for up to four nights when he/she first arrive in Madison as a way to welcome them and help ease their transition to their new environment. This is an invitation to provide welcome and friendship; there is no charge. If you have a spare bedroom and can host for two to four days anytime between August 1 and August 31, please let us know.

□ Airport/Bus Station Pick up, July 30 - August 31

Through this opportunity, you will help pick up a new student at the Dane County airport or the bus station and deliver them to their apartment or dormitory. All the information about the student and the place to drop them off will be given to you in advance. Again, this is a wonderful way to show American hospitality to someone who arrives to America for the first time.

□ Tour of Madison, Labor Day Weekend

The Tour of Madison is a unique opportunity to welcome new International students in Madison, meet new friends, and make a long lasting impression on new comers. Volunteer drivers use their own cars to help transport the student around town following a route specially designed for the occasion. The tour begins with an orientation for drivers and readers and ends with a light reception at one of our members' home. We are in need of more volunteer drivers and readers.

□ Volunteer Drivers and participants for apple picking and picnic in September

Apple picking at Appleberry Farm followed by the picnic at Martha and Rich Henderson's home has become a fall tradition for the International Outreach Ministry as it offers Internationals an excursion in the country side. Volunteer drivers are needed for this activity.

□ International Friendship Program

This program pairs you up with an International student or family for conversation and friendship purpose beyond the Friday gatherings.

You help your partner transition to life in America while learning about your partner's culture.

□ English Conversation Time: Fridays, 6-8pm

English Conversation Time is a flexible program where International students have meaningful interactions with native speakers. The program helps International students practice their English, and gives them the opportunity to learn more about American culture while sharing their own customs and culture with Americans. You can make a huge difference in the life of someone through this opportunity.

□ Global Spouse Circle Volunteers, Thursdays, 1-2:30pm

Moving to the U.S. can be challenging for the spouses of international students and visiting scholars. We know that it can get lonely being at home with their children or alone while their husbands/wives or partners are busy with their studies and research work. The goal of this program is to help international spouses/partner make connections with Americans and find friendships and support within the Madison community as they embark on a new life in the United States.
